The reason for this enrollment process is related to Symsys 210 being limited to 15 students, due to the art drawing and acting components. In the past, the enrollment limit was reached soon after the enrollment period began. Enrollment preference will be given to upper-level undergrads and graduate students who have taken courses in one or more of the following areas: learning, emotions, human-computer interaction, and cognition. The stronger the course background, then better. Experience in art drawing or acting is a plus, but not required, and is not needed in order to do well in the course.

In past years, Symsys 210 was approved as a cognate course in the Psychology and Communications departments, and promoted by the Computer Science HCI faculty. Thus, it is likely that this seminar courses can satisfy an elective requirement in your department. As always, your department can let you know for sure prior to the start of the course.
